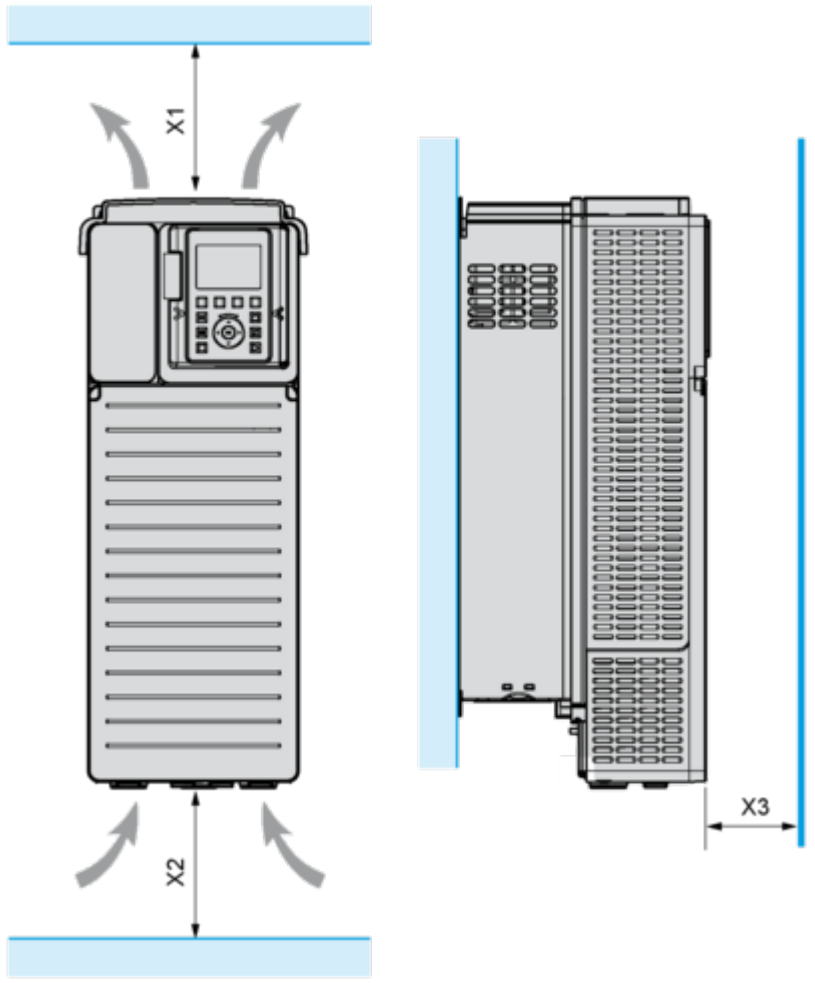

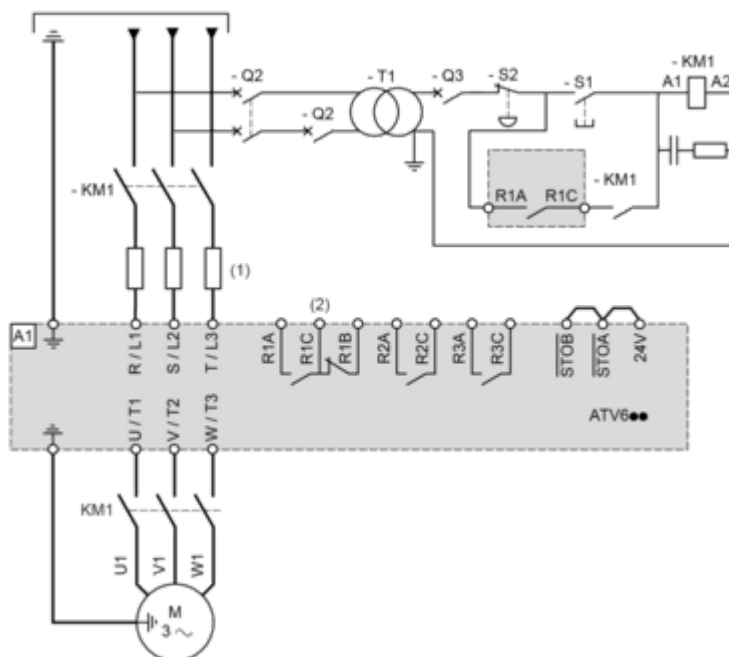

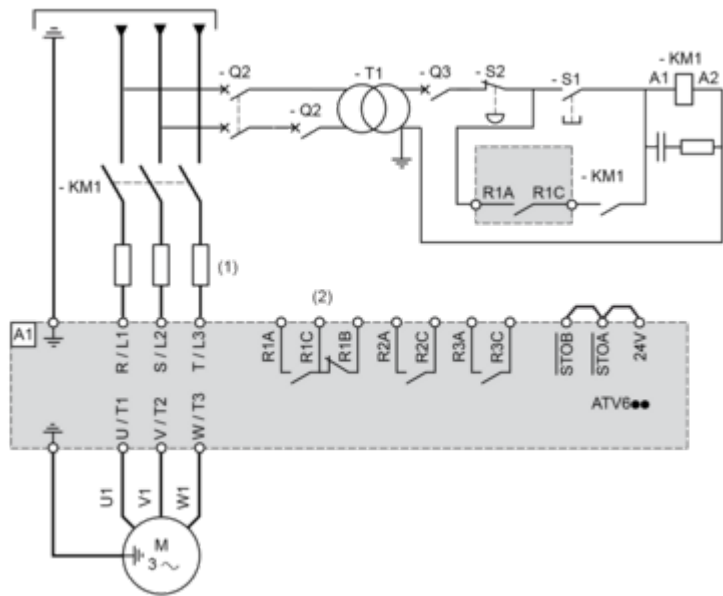

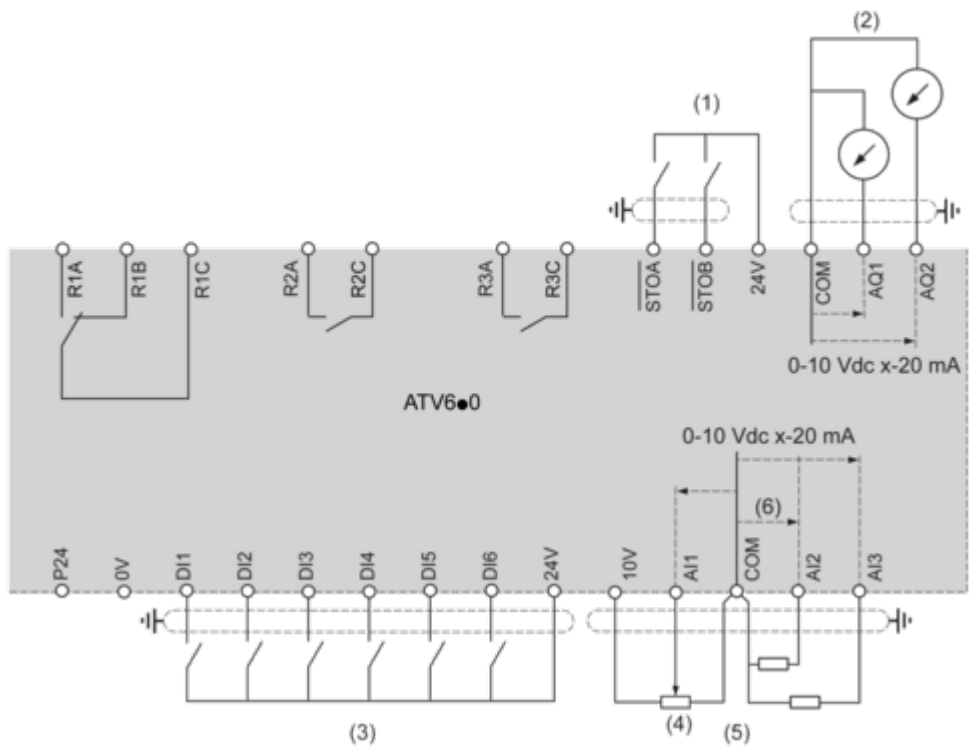
Three-Phase Power Supply with Downstream Breaking via Contactor

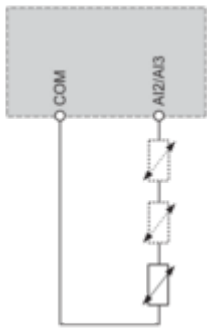
Control Block Wiring Diagram

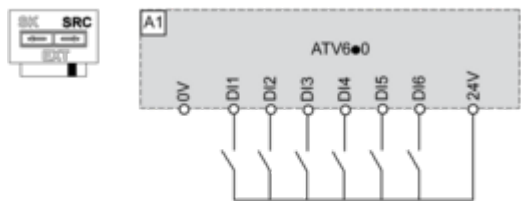


Sink / Source Switch Configuration

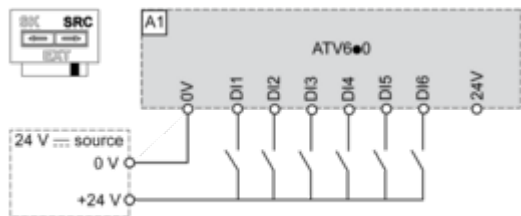
The switch is used to adapt the operation of the logic inputs to the technology of the programmable controller outputs.

- Set the switch to Ext if using PLC outputs with NPN transistors.

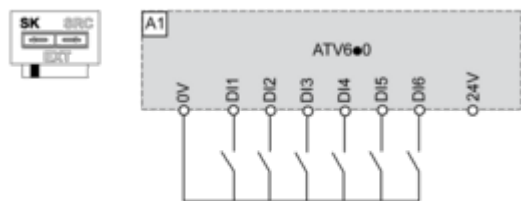
Switch Set to SRC (Source) Position Using the Output Power Supply for the Digital Inputs



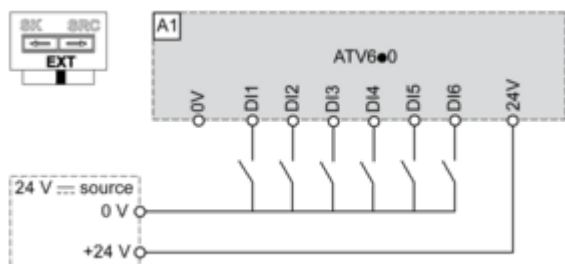
Switch Set to SRC (Source) Position and Use of an External Power Supply for the DIs
